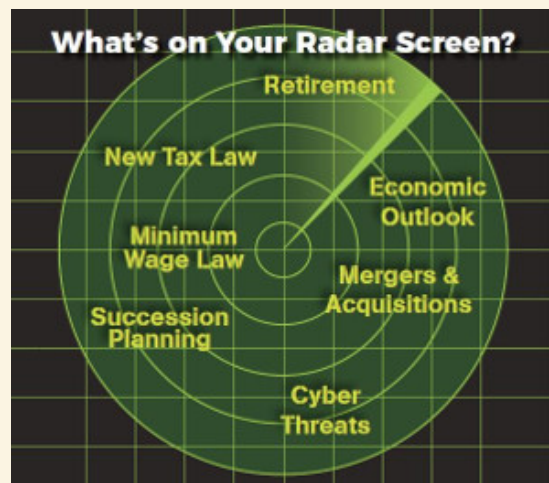
Gray, Gray & Gray team members, family, and friends, also made donations for a raffle to help raise funds for the Boys & Girls Club of Dorchester.
