Shifting Itemized Deductions



Have you changed the way you itemize deductions because of new limitations on state and local taxes and charitable deductions? While some taxpayers have shifted to taking the standard deduction, for many others itemized deductions still offer tax savings. One key is knowing what to itemize, and when.

This is particularly important as we come to the end of the calendar year. Actions taken before December 31, 2019 may help to reduce your taxes in future years. Some of this is long accepted practice, such as accelerating donations you planned to make in 2020 into this year in order to take the deduction sooner or making January's mortgage payment in December so you can take the interest

deduction this year. Other steps are more complex. For example, if your medical costs in 2019 have exceeded (or are approaching) 10% of your adjusted gross income – the threshold at which additional costs are deductible – you might consider having any elective surgery moved up and paying for it this year in order to take the deduction.
