


We are pleased to announce the release of this year's Energy & Propane Industry Survey results!

Your energy business may be eligible for an Employee Retention Tax Credit. The Employee Retention Tax Credit (ERC) was introduced in 2020 as part of the federal government's effort to provide relief to businesses whose revenue declined due to the COVID-19 pandemic. It has since been extended through 2021. Eligible employers can earn a refundable tax credit against certain federal employment taxes.
