

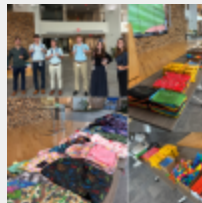

2026 Summer BBQ & Backpack Drive

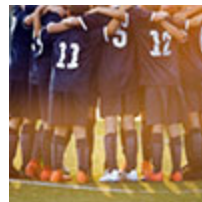
